Dear Parents

We would like to take the children to the Priest House Museum in Wimborne for a Victorian Christmas themed visit. We have been working closely with the museum to ensure a unique and special visit that is centred on our focus of a Victorian Christmas. This visit to the museum is in addition to our usual visit in the New Year. The trip will take place on **Tuesday 5th December**.

Throughout the course of the day the children will be taking part in Christmas activities including crafts and cooking!

We shall be leaving school at **9.15am**, travelling by coach, and will be back in Dorchester before **3.30pm**. If your child normally has a hot dinner on this day this day a packed lunch will need to be provided. Children should bring a snack and drink for a mid-morning break.
