We have significantly reduced the amount of data requested in preparation for the Arts Council Annual Return.

WHAT'S NEW for Key Stage 1 & 2

Instrument choices for Musicianship Programme to have a stronger focus on Orchestral Instruments



You will have received your instrument choices for next year's Musicianship Programme and we look forward to receiving your preference forms. This year, we have chosen to focus more on orchestral instruments to encourage uptake in these instruments. Your choices will reflect this focus, but we are continuing to offer samba, ukulele and recorder to some schools as they are valuable starting blocks from which to learn an orchestral instrument. The skills learnt in the whole class programme are easily transferable for the continuation part of the programme regardless of which instrument they learn as a class.

Demonstrations by our talented musicians in subscribing core schools and The Blandford Schools with Tesco Bags for Help funding will focus on learning orchestral instruments.

Our ever popular instrument demonstrations will begin again in September. These demonstrations are the perfect way to inspire your pupils to learn to play a musical instrument and explore the different instruments available. Our team of musicians will visit your school to deliver a 30 minute assembly which focuses on different instruments with demonstrations of each instruments capabilities and a whole host of wonderful music along the way! Did you know? We subsidise tuition by £6 an hour for Dorset students with Hub funding. This is because we have a moral duty to offer tuition to all Dorset students regardless of which area of Dorset they live in. There are a wealth of competitors out there but often these competitors are not willing to travel for 30 minutes tuition to a Dorset village 40 miles from their home. We never turn work away due to distance and we are working hard to maintain a catalogue of Instructors that can meet demand. To do this we need to be able to offer them
