Parent Question 1 -

	The old PT was dangerous and had to be removed, and its location also posed an issue at break times. He assured XXX that the space will be used to the best advantage.
Parent Question 2 -	
XXX asked about Power Maths. Is the new work book like an old school text book?	GSp The book is not an old school style text book as it contains so much more than just a textbook, the book will stay at school.
Parent Question 3 -	
XXX asked about feedback. Will this now be given back to the children straight away?	GSp - Feedback will be a whole class sheet and actioned immediately. We will remain fluid about how we look at children as individuals rather than the group they are in. This way any problems can be addressed quicker. Live marking will also still be happening. Previously books were not being looked at every day now they will be.

XXX asked if the children had mentioned that there isn't a morning break now.	GSp Said that they hadn't yet! They have, however, gained 10 minutes playtime at lunch time. Mr Treble will now be offering sports clubs at lunchtime and an after-school club. More lunchtime clubs will be added as the restaurant is embedded.

XXX asked if we are still keeping the fun things?	GSp - Yes! We have lots planned, the first being Food/Farming fortnight. Then we have something in December which will be STEM week. He assured everyone that more costumes WILL follow!
