## Year Four - Summer Term Newsletter 2019

Dear Parents and Carers,

Welcome back to the summer term. It's been an unexpected start to the term with the absence of Miss Johnson, although the children have adjusted incredibly well. It has helped that the children were already familiar with me and Mr Dickinson who has returned to complete his final teaching placement. All the staff have noticed a growing maturity and focus in the children as they prepare themselves for the transition to middle school.

## Topic

We will be studying The Celts and The Romans this term. There is lots of local history in this topic with links to Design Technology, Literacy, Art and Drama.

It's going to be a very busy and exciting term with lots of trips and overnight stays, themed weeks and transfer activities.

## Walking to School

During the summer term, some parents and carers may wish to organise for their children to walk part or all of the way to school by themselves.

In the past, some very successful walking parties have been organised by groups of parents in order to develop their children's sense of independence in getting ready for walking to middle school.

If you do decide to organise for your child to walk some or all of the way to or from school, please ensure that you let the school office know in writing and the Year 4 team know.

## **Snacks and Water**

To maximise our brain function and encourage a healthy lifestyle we would like children to bring a healthy snack to school each day to eat at break in addition to a bottle of water. We are encouraging the children to drink and









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eat smart by keeping hydrated through the day and be conscious of what they are eating. Snacks such as crisps and sweets will be positively discouraged.

## **Reading and Writing**

This term we are prioritising punctuation and grammar in Year 4, please encourage your child to use their punctuation when writing at home, especially correct use of capital letters. Many children in Year 4 continue to be very enthusiastic readers, please continue to value books with your children at home. We would also encourage them to complete their Accelerated Reader quizzes once they finish reading a book.

It is essential that your child remembers to bring their book bag to school every day. Year 4 children need to begin to be responsible for remembering this and organising themselves in readiness for middle school. Book bags are needed for Library, Quiet reading, Group reading sessions and spelling activities as well as Individual reading to teachers, classroom assistants and parent helpers. A record is kept of books going in and out of the library, so it is important that children do not put their library book back without registering it.
