Notes and Actions -

1.0 - GSp provided a staffing update about Miss. Johnson.	Ms Browne will lead Year 4 with Mr Dickinson for the foreseeable future. GSP will oversee this.
2.0 - GSp provided a Maths Mastery update – GSp explained that as a school we looked at a number of options, including Shanghai Maths, before making the decision of what resource we would go with. We took time to make the changes in Maths to ensure the best for the school. We have gone with "Power Maths". Staff will have training in September and resources will be needed.	Question asked if this would run with Mathletics. GSp said it would still be used alongside Mathletics and explained how this would work. All children need to be able to "lift the lid" to allow children to go as high as they want, seeking to embrace more knowledge.
3.0 - Children's Voice - GSp discussed how the Children's Voice had raised an issue about Girls and Sports with in the school. They have requested specific time for "Girls Only" sessions and this is being arranged.	We also now have "This Girl Can" which is a sports club for Year 3 and 4. This has already started and is proving to be very popular.
4.0 - Outside Space – GSp updated about where we are with the Outside Space, and that we now only need a few more resources for it to be fully functional.	A request is being made to POWSA (and approved) for these items. We now have outside learning areas (new sheds) that will be used for RWInc.

5.0 - Eco Schools - A Green Flag Assessor visited our Question asked if they look different as the parent was worried school recently and has reported that we will keep about peer pressure from children because some parents may not our Green Flag status. be able to pay the extra for the Eco uniform?
